rooster made in France called "cocotte"


introduction

The rooster, called "cocotte" or "coq" in France, is a marker to indicate customer that the brand is made in France and much more, a lot of products are made in France.

Dealer can use this marker on the entrance signage in these two cases:

- on the yellow overhead panel
- on the yellow vertical marker

It's only for volunteers, not mandatory at all.






rooster made in France called "cocotte"

details on the rooster

The rooster must be black (satin or mat finished).

The pictogram is to be provided in black adhesive letter by letter striped, equivalent to RAL 9005, specific to an outdoor application.

It could be directly printed on the stretched fabric, but adhesive is recommended.




rooster on overhead panel





rooster on the overhead panel






The width of the overhead panel is divided into 20 "x" units. That gives us the format of the cocotte, which must be 3 "x".


The protection zone around the pictogram must respect 1 "x"

rooster on the vertical marker





rooster on the vertical marker

The width of the overhead panel is divided into 4 "x" units. That gives us the format of the cocotte, which must be 2 "x".

The protection zone around the pictogram must respect 1"x"
