## rules for car plates in dealerships

cars displayed in showrooms must be equipped with 2 different plates, one at the front, one at the rear car name and brand must be written in thick lettering
ready-to-print files for most cars are available on BrandHub: https://brand.renault.com/fundamental-guidelines/renault/carmarking
if the plate you look for isn't published, templates for both long and short cars names are at your disposal, you must use them.
