rules for car plates in dealerships

cars displayed in showrooms must be equipped with 2 different plates, one at the front, one at the rear

 $\langle \rangle$

- car name and brand must be written in thick lettering
- ready-to-print files for most cars are available on BrandHub: <u>https://brand.renault.com/fundamental-guidelines/renault/car-marking</u>
- if the plate you look for isn't published, templates for both long and short cars names are at your disposal, you must use them.

for EV cars

- h. 110 mm x l. 520 mm with 4 angles (radius 10 mm)
- plate base: 3 mm white expanded PVC
- front plate: vehicle name in 3 mm black expanded PVC lettering, motorization in black printing
- rear plate: word "RENAULT" in 3 mm black expanded PVC lettering


